Learning Ladders was founded in 2015 by Matt Koster-Marcon, with a dual mission to upskill parents so they could better support their child's learning at home, and rescue teachers from unnecessary admin tasks.

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The Learning Ladders Story

Matt was a teacher in inner-London Primary Schools and recognised the need to show parents how to help learning at home, but that teachers simply didn't have the time to provide this support in the depth needed.

Part of this was because teachers were overwhelmed with admin tasks, often related to the use of old fashioned data trackers and reporting systems.

Matt recognised that by connecting better in-school assessments with pre-written support for parents at home, the two key challenges facing schools and teachers could be solved together.

He had the idea to create a series of short tutorials specifically for parents, to upskill them remotely on-demand on the exact skills their child was currently working on, so they knew exactly how to help at home.

These tutorials would be personalised automatically by the platform to the exact work each child is working on in school, for every subject, every week.

This meant the school platform would need to enable the school to design any curriculum structure, for any subject, in any language, and then assess it in any way they choose.

Nothing like this existed, and so Learning Ladders was born.

For the last 5 years the focus of Learning Ladders has been extensive product development and market testing, making sure the system works for schools.

This year that work was recognised when Learning Ladders was the recipient of the BETT Award for 'Best Whole School system for Teaching, Learning and Assessment', as well as being shortlisted for 'Best system for Home Learning and Parental Engagement'.

Matt is proud to see an idea born in a London classroom already supports students, teachers and parents across the world, but with new innovations already in development is even more excited about what's to come.
