Then, as now, the company's aim was 'To help those who teach' by providing high-quality teaching resources for the entire teaching community. What started as a small but ambitious 'after work' business quickly grew.

By 2014, Twinkl had 45 employees and had already moved to its current Sheffield HQ. Things didn't stop there.

Today, Twinkl is the world's largest provider of high-quality, printable, primary teaching resources.

We've become a multi-national organisation, with over 400 team members around the globe.

- Experience in animation


Soft Skills:
